4.3 Defendants Dong K. Lee and Poong Lee breached their duty of care and their duty to act reasonably by, among other things, negligently entrusting a motor vehicle to WiH. Lee, a person they knew or should have known was reckless and/or incompetent to operate a motor vehicle.

4.4 As a result of Defendants Dong K.
